Your child's class will be involved in the GOOD-TOUCH/BAD-TOUCH program, and we want you to be aware of it so that you can answer your child's questions and reinforce our discussions at home.

GOOD-TOUCH/BAD-TOUCH is a body safety program that teaches our children a very comfortable way to talk about a very sensitive problem. Informing children of the following concepts helps to lessen their vulnerability to abuse and helps to demonstrate their voice to speak out and keep themselves safe.

1. Touch can be good, bad, or confusing.
2. Children are special, and they have the right to know all the safety rules.
3. Children can say NO! to touches they don't like.
4. Children can tell a trusted adult if they ever have a problem with sexual abuse or other confusing touches.
5. Sexual abuse is NEVER the child's fault.

All materials to be used will be available for parents to view. Items will be placed on our webpage.
